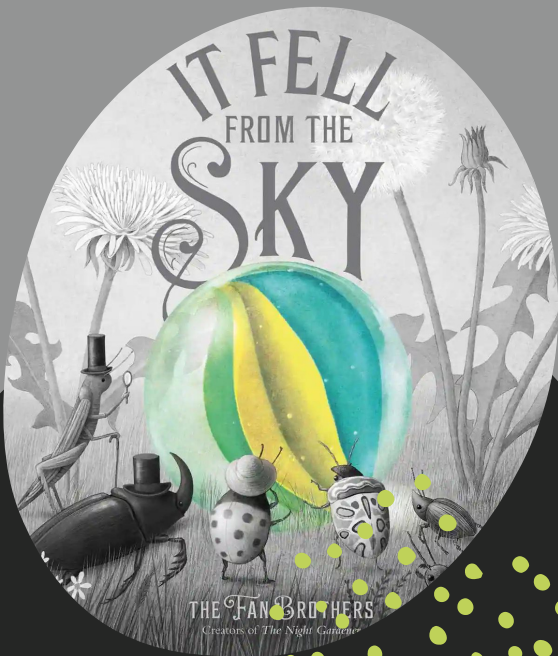


IT FELL FROM THE SKY
